Easy Care Gardening (ECG) values its employees and volunteers and is committed to ensuring their health, safety and welfare. ECG complies with NSW Work Health Safety (WHS) Act 2012.

Responsibilities of Easy Care Gardening (ECG)

- a. ECG maintains places of work which are under our control in a safe condition, and ensuring safe entrances and exits
- b. ECG ensures the safe use, handling, storage and transport of plant and substances.
- c. ECG provides and maintains systems of work, and environments, that are safe and without risk to health
- d. ECG provides information, instruction, training and supervision necessary to ensure the health and safety of employees and volunteers
- e. ECG consults with employees and volunteers about WHS matters, so that they can contribute to decisions affecting their health, safety and welfare.

Responsibilities of Easy Care Gardening Volunteers & Employees

- a. Volunteers & Employees must take reasonable care of the health and safety of themselves and others.
- b. Volunteers & Employees must co-operate with ECG in its efforts to comply with workplace health and safety requirements.
- c. Volunteers & Employees must not interfere with or misuse things provided for the health, safety or welfare of other employees or volunteers.
- d. Volunteers & Employees must not obstruct attempts to give aid or attempts to prevent a serious risk to the health and safety of a person at work.
- e. Volunteers & Employees must not refuse a reasonable request to assist in giving aid or preventing a risk to health and safety.
- f. Volunteers & Employees must not disrupt a workplace by creating health or safety fears.
